EVENT SCHEDULE	Thursday, July 30, 2026 11-12, 13-14, & 15-18 individual prelims for all events except unified events. This session does not include any relays. Friday, July 31, 2026 8-U & 9-10 individual prelims. Timed Finals for 8-U Relays. This session does not include any unified events. Saturday, August 1, 2026 All individual event finals and all relay timed finals except 8-U Relays. Includes all unified event finals. Meet Start Every morning, the session starts at 8:00 am. Start time for the afternoon sessions is TBD; they are estimated to begin one hour after the end of the morning sessions. A detailed listing of events is included at the end of the Meet Description. The administrative referee, the meet directors, and the meet referee reserve the right to include breaks in the schedule.

PROTESTS	1. Protests against judgment decisions of deck referees, starters, stroke, turn, place, and relay take-off judges can only be considered by the Meet Referee, and the Meet Referee's decision is final. a. For individual preliminary events, all protests for results and/or disqualifications must be made to the Meet Referee within 60 minutes of the results being posted. 60 minutes after the results are posted, the event results will be considered closed and final if no protests have been filed. b. For finals and timed finals, the Protest period will be 60 minutes from the end of the event. For the last event of the meet, the 60-minute rule may be waived with the approval of the head coaches (or their designees) of swimmers who were disqualified.

	c. Protests regarding an athlete's competition category can only be heard by the All-City Board Rules Committee. 2. Protests for all other administrative and competition-related protests, including protests concerning eligibility and representation, protests against timing decisions or facility-related issues, must be made to the Meet Referee and submitted within thirty (30) minutes after the end of the race in which the alleged issue occurred. For the purpose of considering these protests, the Meet Referee will appoint a meet committee consisting of not fewer than three (3) and not more than five (5) persons, at least one of whom shall be a coach and one an athlete. 3. If an eligibility question of an athlete cannot be resolved before an athlete's race, the athlete is allowed to swim. The athlete's eligibility cannot be established after the race; this swim will be marked "exhibition only". To meet the 30-minute requirement, it is sufficient to voice a protest orally. If needed, the Meet Referee may request a more detailed written request before the meet committee meeting. The coach making the protest may not be a member of the meet committee, but they may present it. In addition, neither the meet referee nor anyone else directly involved in making the decision subject to the protest shall be a decision-making member of the meet committee.
TIMING SYSTEM	Primary timing will be fully automatic, secondary timing will be semi-automatic, and tertiary timing will be manual. For 8 & Under individual events where the finish is not at the start end of the pool, primary timing will be a semi-automatic system with a secondary timing system of manual watches. Hy-Tek software will be used.
ELIGIBILITY	All participants shall meet the eligibility requirements of the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules.
RULES	Governing documents are the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules. The 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules shall override any discrepancy contained in this Meet Description. The 2026 All-City Meet is an observed USA Swimming meet.
ADMISSIONS	There is no charge for admission. Heat sheets will be available for download on a personal device. Event information will be available via the app. Reserved seats are not permitted in the spectator section.
CONCESSIONS	A selection of food and beverage items will be available for purchase throughout the meet.
MEET ENTRY	Meet Entry process shall follow Article VIII B of the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules.
CLERK OF COURSE	All participants must comply with the Clerk of Course reporting requirements of the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules.
WARM-UPS	Except for the host team, warm-ups are not provided in the competition pool during the meet. The warm-up schedule is set in accordance with the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules and is as follows:

INITIAL DEADLINE	As outlined in the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules, the Initial Deadline is set as Sunday, July 26, 2026, at 9:00 pm CDT.	
MEET FORMAT	INDIVIDUAL EVENTS All individual events will be conducted in a prelims-finals format, except for unified events. Unified events will be conducted in a timed finals format. Preliminary individual events for the 11-12, 13-14, and 15-18 age groups shall take place on Thursday. Preliminary individual events for the 8-U and 9-10 age groups shall take place on Friday. Two heats of each individual event will compete in the Finals on Saturday. Participants will consist of the top 16 qualifiers. RELAY EVENTS All relay events shall be conducted in a timed finals format. 8-U relay events will take place on Friday. All remaining age-group medley relays and all remaining age-group free relays will take place on Saturday. Relay cards will be distributed to all coaches. Changes may be made until the start of the event, but they must be clearly noted on the relay card. First names, last names, age, and the order of the swimmers must be legibly written on all relay cards. Meet management reserves the right to combine age and gender exhibition relays.	
SCRATCHING FROM FINALS	See 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules.	
FINAL EVENTS	During finals, a swimmer who does not report to the Clerk of Course before the start of the consolation final heat of the previous event of the same gender (i.e., two prior events) shall be considered a no-show and not allowed to compete in that event. For example: Swimmers in event 13 shall report to the clerk of course by the start of event 11; swimmers in event 14 shall report to the clerk of course by the start of event 12; and swimmers in event 24 shall report to the clerk of course by the start of event 22. In the event of withdrawal, the Referee shall fill the consolation final or final with the next qualified swimmer(s). Additional provisions are provided in the 2026 Madison All-City Swim/Dive League Rules.	

OBSERVATION	The 2026 meet is an observed meet. This means that times achieved at this meet may be entered into the USA Swimming SWIMS database upon request. For a request to be successful, the following is required. 1. USA Swimming Athlete membership at the time of the All-City Meet; 2. A USA Swimming athlete membership number; 3. Submit a request form to the Administrative Referee by visiting https://7xscoring.com/all-city/observation/ 4. Successful payment of a \$20 administration fee per athlete with your online request form. Requests can be submitted until July 29 at 9 p.m. CDT. Only requests through the online form with payment will be accepted. Late requests will be accepted until August 4 at 9 p.m. CDT for a late fee. Contact Austin Lacey, Administrative Referee, with questions.
AIR QUALITY	Parkcrest will monitor the local AQI (Air Quality Index) hourly at the closest Wisconsin DNR air-quality monitoring station. If the AQI exceeds 200 in three consecutive readings (updated every 30 minutes), we will take the necessary steps to cancel or postpone the day's competition to ensure the safety of swimmers, officials, and spectators. The policy is in line with USA Swimming's Outdoor Air Quality regulations.
COACHES MEETING	Coach's meetings will be held every morning prior to the start of the day. Each meeting will take place at 7:15 am. Additional meetings can be called as needed.
SWIMMERS W/ DISABILITIES	Coaches of swimmers with disabilities who request special accommodations shall submit the request to the All-City Board Rules Committee prior to Thursday, July 30. The coach will be notified by the Rules Committee of the decision related to the request. If the accommodation request is not known until the start of the meet, the Meet Referee and Meet Director should be told at the coaches' meeting.

VOLUNTEERS	Each guest team will be asked to provide at least one Clerk of Course and Timer volunteer per session. Each guest team will also be asked to provide an additional number of volunteers to time and/or clerk. The number will be based on the needs of the host pool and, equitably, proportional to the pool's participation (measured by number of swimmers) in the previous year's All-City swim meet.
MEET CONDUCT	The Madison All-City Swim & Dive League requires positive sporting behavior at all meets, including the Championship meet. Participating in and attending the All-City swim meet is a privilege that includes the expectation that all behavior and actions are positive and respectful for everyone in attendance.
