



All-City Swim Championship 2026 – Entries Timeline and Information

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Entry Process Highlights:

- Standard entry period is on Sunday, July 26, 2026 from 8:00 AM CT – 9:00 pm CDT
- Swimmers must have competed in three (3) All-City League dual meets during the 2025 season in an individual event. Meet Management will conduct checks on eligibility using the All-City results database. Note: invitational meets do not count towards this requirement.
- Entries will be accepted virtually at <https://7xscoring.com/meets/all-city-2026/>
 - Enter in all individual events and all relays teams with seed times on Sunday 7/26
 - Enter relay only swimmers in event 201 or event 202
 - Relay names are required for 8 under medley relays and 8 and under freestyle relays
 - **NEW FOR 2026: for 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-19 Relays - only enter relay teams that will have four legal swimmers in Events #3-10 and #63-70. For relays without four legal swimmers, enter them into exhibition events #301/302 (medley) and #303/304 (free).**
 - All other relay names are due 3 hours after the conclusion of the meet on Friday 7/31
 - Seed times should be in SCY. Any non-SCY times will automatically be converted to SCY.
 - Proof your entries during your warm-up time and stop by to see Austin to sign-off
 - Ensure only Unified swimmers are entered in the unified events
 - For 15-19 year olds: if choosing to swim fly or IM, they can only enter into one distance of these strokes (i.e. 50 fly OR 100 fly; 100 IM OR 200 IM)
 - Email, call or text if you have any questions/issues
- Splash fees should be brought during your warm-up period
- **Psych sheets will be posted late on July 26.** Report any issues ASAP. Note that seed times cannot be changed (unless error by meet management) after the initial entry deadline.
- **This meet is designated as a USA Swimming Observed meet.** This means that times from the meet can be entered into SWIMS if the swimmer completes an observation request form and submits the administrative payment at <https://7xscoring.com/all-city/observation/> by July 29, 9 pm CT.

Scratching from Finals:

- You must report scratches from finals to the Administrative Referee or an Administrative Official within 30 minutes after the end of the session in which the preliminary swim was conducted.

Meet management will conduct eligibility checks using All-City League results database. 15-19 year olds can only enter into one individual event per stroke (i.e. 50 fly OR 100 fly, not both) - Exhibition relays (those with less than 4 legal swimmers) should be entered into events #301/302 (medley) and #303/304 (free). 8 & Under Medley and Freestyle Relays due WITH names.	- Entry fee \$20/swimmer to be collected at your warm-ups - Submit HY-TEK format of entries and accompanying PDF electronically online at https://7xscoring.com/meets/all-city-2026/ - Stop by to see the AR to sign-off on your entries - Seed times should be in SCY or they will automatically be converted to SCY upon upload. - Enter relay only swimmers in events 201 and 202 for tracking purposes - Teams must submit all relays with seed times. Exhibition relays for ages 9 & Up (those with less than 4 legal swimmers) should be entered into events #301/302, and #303/304. Relay names are only required for 8 & under medley and freestyle relays relays at this time. - Head coach should have all waivers on file. - Ensure <u>only</u> Unified swimmers are entered in the unified events
